- ✓ Amphitheater of Carthage within 8,7 km
- ✓ The Acropolium Saint Louis Cathedral within 8,8 km
- ✓ Carthage National Museum within 8,9 km
- ✓ Cathedral of St. Vincent de Paul within 16,4 km

It is the perfect destination to rest in the thalassotherapy center inspired by the traditions of Carthage, to entertain in the water park or you can practice various sporting activities in the fitness center or on the tennis or volleyball courts of the hotel.

Moreover, the hotel propose an outdoor and indoor swimming pools, poolside bar, coffee shop or café, a snack bar, a piano bar, an Internet Point, room service 24h/24, free WIFI available in all establishment.

From the airport:

Take the RN9 and leave the Boulevard of Leader Yesser Arafet, then follow the N9 then take the R23 towards your destination in Gammarth (26 min).

Motorway from Tunis city center:

From Avenue Habib Bourguiba you should follow the R23 towards Gammarth (29 min).



The hotel is only accessible by taxi (no public transportation).

To go from Carthage Thalasso Resort Hotel to the Phoebus Hotel, you should take the South-West direction and then turn right (4 min).

Capital: Tunis

Tunis is both the capital and the largest city of Tunisia, situated in the North East of the country, on the Mediterranean coast. Because of its geographic situation, between the Western and Eastern Mediterranean and between Africa and Europe, Tunis is the focus of Tunisian political and administrative life and also the center of the country's commercial activity.

Tunis is a city steeped in history but resolutely dynamic, where past and present are closely mixed. Founded by the Phoenicians in 814 BC and then rebuilt by the Romans, Tunis still retains some impressive vestiges such as those of the Antonine Baths, villas and the Roman theater. A fascinating Museum brings the history and civilization of this glorious ancient city. It is also the incredible beauty of the neighboring village drawn in blue and white "Sidi Bou Saïd", an attaching blend of simplicity and refinement that dominates the Gulf of Tunis from the top of a hill.

Indeed, the northern suburbs of Tunis, the Goulette and Sidi Bou Saïd, is the best place in the capital where to spend quiet and very pleasant evenings, at the seaside, in a typical outdoor cafe or an exotic restaurant. The discreet charm of these neighborhoods is known in Tunisia and throughout the Mediterranean.

A little further, towards Gammarth, a rather trendy nightlife imposes itself with last hits from all genres.

Tunisia is characterized by a Mediterranean climate: high temperatures in the south, however, summers are everywhere hot and dry, the mid seasons are cool and cold with humid winters.

In May, temperatures may vary between 22°C and 28 °C.
