European Union - free movement of workers

Freedom of movement and residence for persons in the EU – a cornerstone of Union citizenship, established by Treaty of Maastricht 1992

EU facilitates free movement of workers and intra-EU mobility by supporting EURES

EURES - network between EU Commission and Public Employment Services (PES) of EU-28 countries, Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein and Switzerland

EURES - launched 1993 to exchange job vacancies and provide information about living and working conditions

Targeted mobility scheme- Your first EURES job

Intra EU labour market activation measure, launched 2012 - initiative by the European Commission,

Purpose: address labour market imbalances – low mobility in EU, high unemployment among youth

Help young EU citizens aged 18-35 to find a job in another EU member state

Combining tailor-made recruitment, matching and placement services with financial supports for jobseekers and employers

Key to success - identify skills shortages and help employers to recruit

New pilot project Reactivate (aged 35+) start 2016

Your first EURES job Sweden - scope and aim

Help young jobseekers to find work and match employers with hard to fill vacancies across Europe

- All economic sectors covered
- Focus on shortages and surpluses (ICT, engineering, health care, teachers, chefs.), mainly within our Consortium EURES/countries as well as within the European labour market
- Main cooperation with PES/EURES in our partner countries, but open to all EU countries

- **Duration until 2019**
- **Placement services with financial supports**

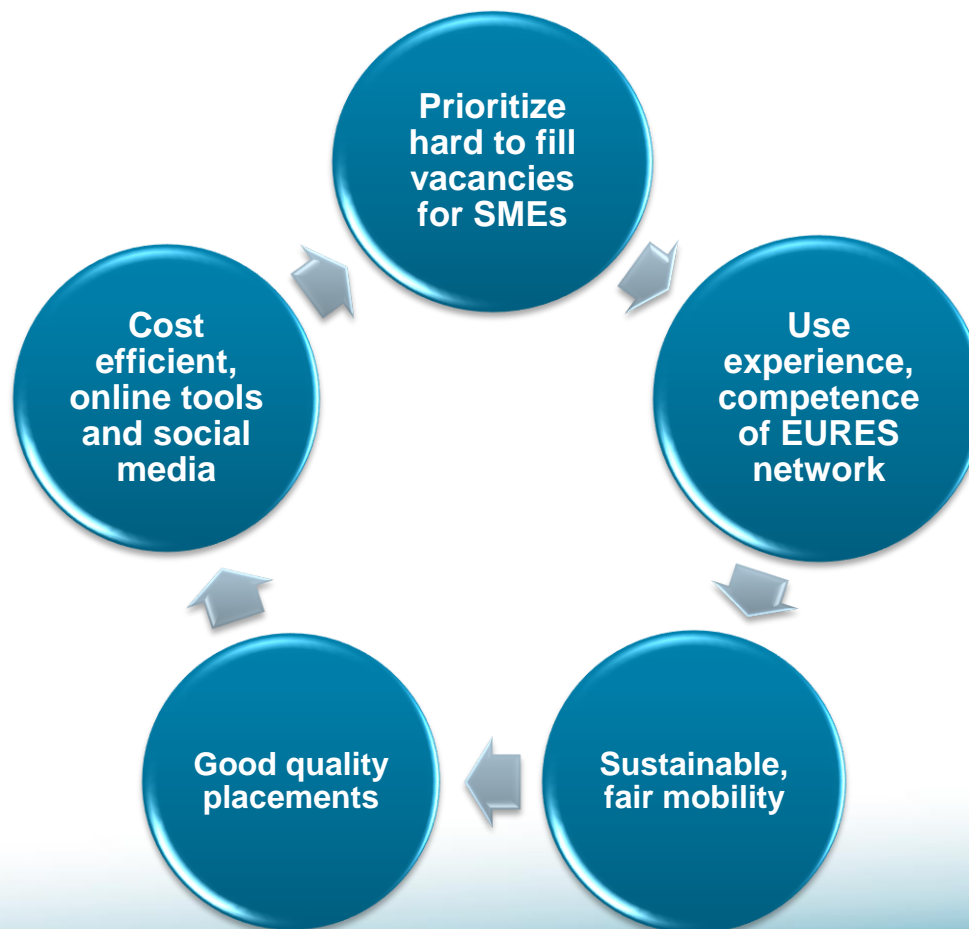

Services to target groups

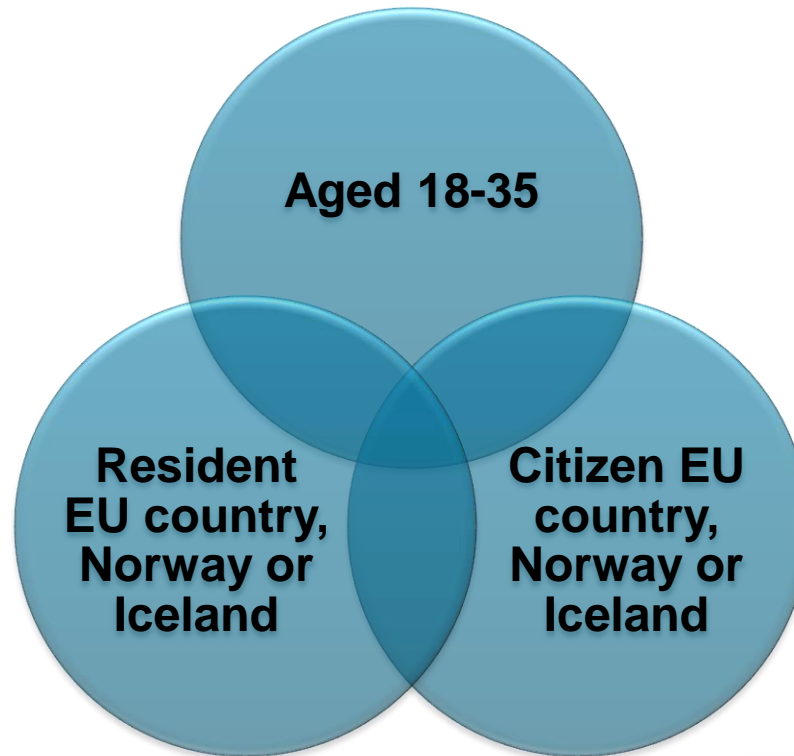
Jobseekers

Mobility services: matching to suitable jobs, employer contact, preparation before taking up a job abroad

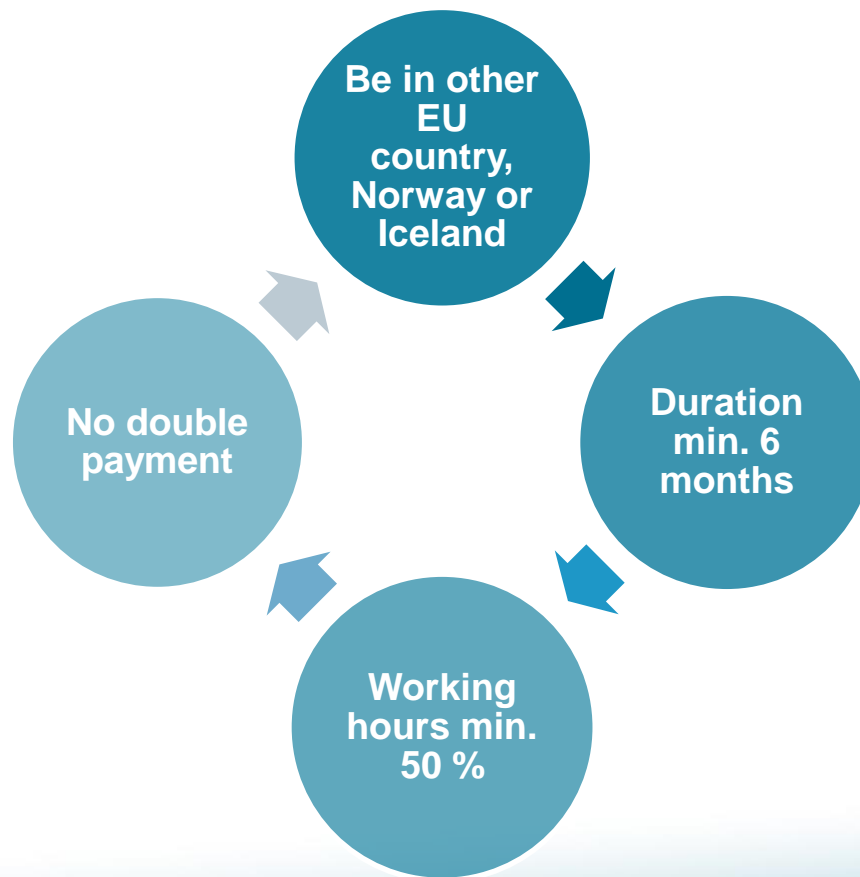
Employers
