A. The commissioning party

The BMZ returnee programme “Returning to New Opportunities”

- Implementation of the BMZ programme by the global Programme “Programme Migration for Development” and about 25 other GIZ actions in partner countries.
- **To improve returnees prospects and create opportunities for migrants returning to their countries of origin**
- **12 partner countries:** Kosovo, Albania, Serbia, Tunisia, Morocco, Nigeria, Ghana, Senegal, Iraq, Afghanistan, *Egypt, Pakistan*

C. An specificity: the reintegration scouts

Reintegration scouts

- Throughout Germany, up to **15 reintegration scouts** support the **returnee advice centres set up by the civil society or public authorities** at municipal and regional levels.
- They form a **link between counselling for potential returnees** in Germany and **German development cooperation projects** in migrants' countries of origin.
- Returning counselors have thus **more information about the reintegration** opportunities proposed by GIZ, government institutions and civil society organizations in the field.
- Scouts disseminate information on the labor market, the promotion of entrepreneurship and other opportunities in the country of origin.

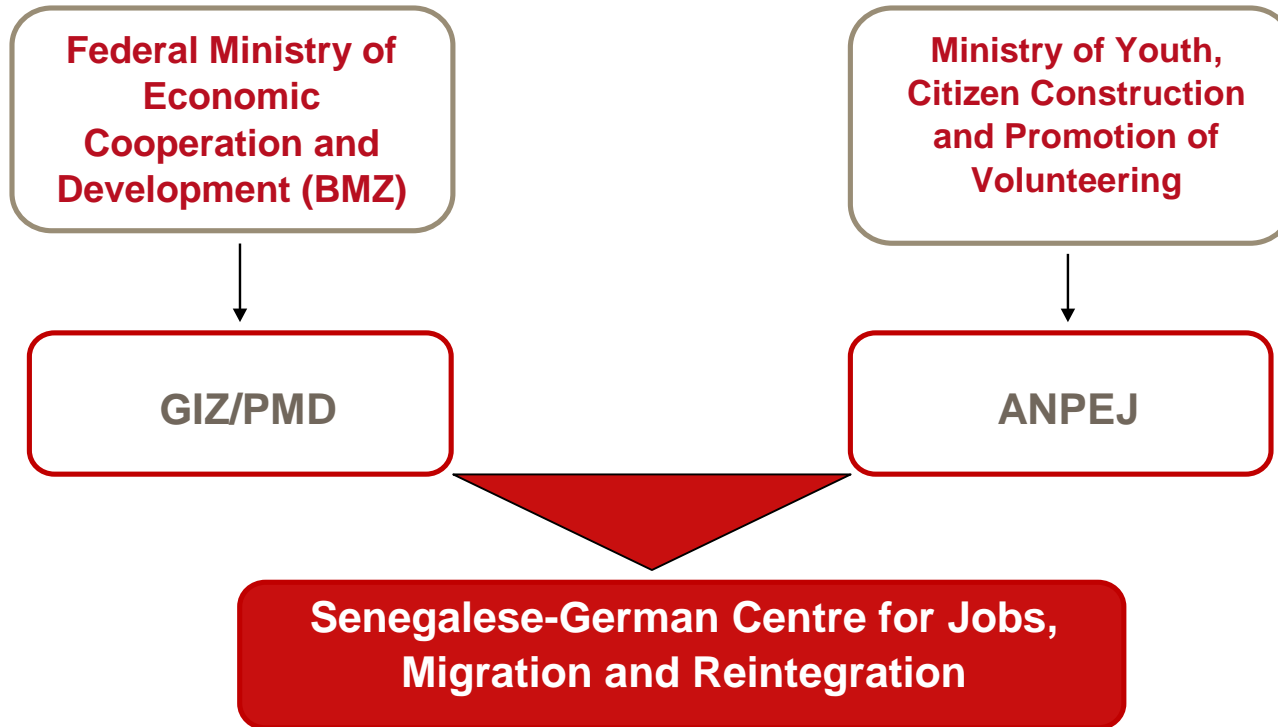

B. Objectives of the Centre

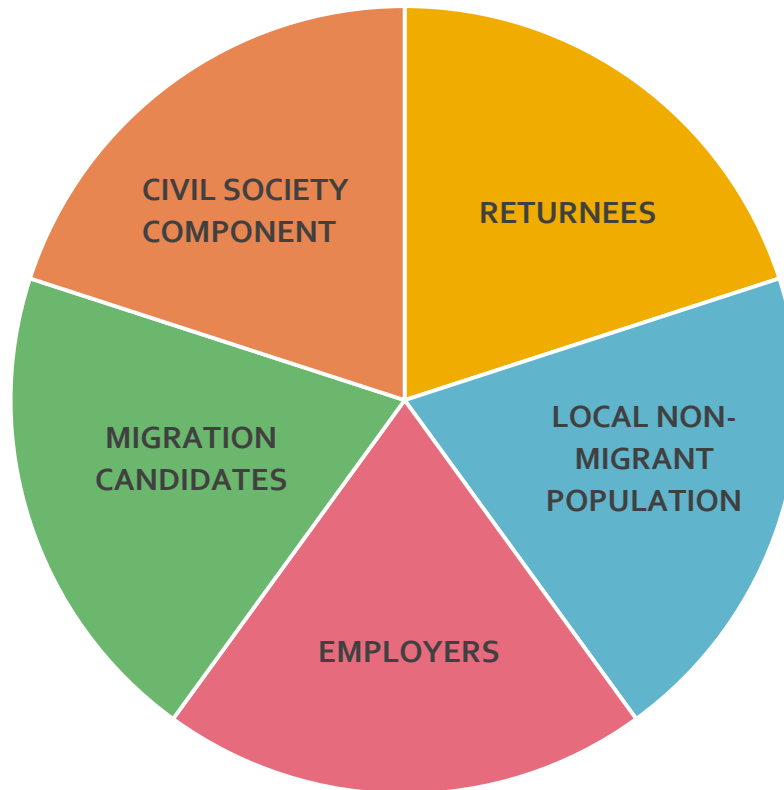
To create opportunities for integration into the labor market in Senegal, Germany and third countries

D. Activities proposed by the Centre

The Center runs its activities throughout the national territory. To this end, the Center mobilizes ANPEJ regional offices, migrant associations and support systems for migrants to meet the needs of target groups. The following activities are organized outside the reception and information system:

- Awareness-raising and information sessions (individual and collective);
- Entrepreneurship training sessions and technical training according to the needs of the target groups;
- Collective and individual coaching in job searching techniques.

The main objective of the Center is to foster **job creation** through the deployment of measures.
