





About Public Employment Service of Kazakhstan



Annually provide services for \approx 850 thousand citizens or \approx 9% of the labour force (9.6 million people)









Providing employment services

For job seekers

- Registration of the unemployed
- Assistance in employment
- Referring the unemployed to wage subsidy programs (youth internship, jobs for socially vulnerable groups, public works, Silver Age)
- Short-term vocational training
- Providing assistance for the purpose of targeted social support
- Voluntary resettlement of citizens to labordeficient regions
- Supporting entrepreneurship (training in the basics of entrepreneurship, grants)

For employers

- Consulting and providing information on the labor market
- Recruitment of personnel for registered vacancies
- Vocational training upon employer's request
- Subsidizing jobs
- Receiving information from employers about the dismissal of employees







107 thousand people with unemployed status received certificates







Success stories of the Skills Enbek platform

Skills Enbek is a single showcase of online courses on in-demand skills thanks to integration with leading national and international educational platforms for easy and convenient search of existing online courses on the market




































Development of VR courses
