- To set up a support and guidance mechanism for integration and entrepreneurship in green industries;
- Encourage the creation of markets linked to the green economy;
- Set up a national observatory to monitor the creation of green jobs.



# **Strategic priority 2: Capacity building and improving employability**

Specific major projects	Expected results
Solidarity project to create urban parks and reforestation in 10 regions.	100 hectares of woodland and reforestation and 1,000 jobs for composters and landscapers are created
Creation of 5 plastics recycling units	1,400 green jobs created from 5 plastics recycling units installed
Creation of 2 composting centres for municipal solid waste	6,000 jobs created by 2 municipal solid waste composting centres installed

# Strategic priority 2: Capacity building and improving employability

Specific major projects	Expected results
Installation of 10 biogas production units from municipal solid waste	500 jobs are being created as a result of the construction of 10 biogas production units using municipal solid waste.
Pilot project to create a waste exchange through the development of ICT applications (Green IT) in five (05) of the country's major cities:	A virtual market (supply and demand) is up and running, and 500 green jobs have been created (information pre-collectors, waste recycling technicians, developers and virtual platform coordinators, etc.).
Green Start up project: Identifying and setting up start-ups in green industries with high job creation potential	10 start-ups are identified and supported in green sectors with high job creation potential

### 5 September 2022: Signature of an agreement with ANAGED

(National Waste Management Agency)

- Implementing income-generating activities (IGAs) in the field of health and sanitation;
- Implementation of labour-intensive sanitation and hygiene projects;
- information, training, support, monitoring and advice;
- joint fundraising and project implementation.

### CONSTRUCTION AND EQUIPPING OF A UNIT TO TRANSFORM HOUSEHOLD WASTE INTO COMPOST IN WOROFLA (WORODOUGOU REGION)

The construction and equipping of the composting plant buildings was co-financed by the State, the Swiss Embassy and the Worofla Town Hall. The components were as follows

- Construction of the composting plant;
- Educating the population about sorting;
- Provision of sanitation equipment;
- Recruitment and technical training of the workforce.

The Agence Emploi Jeunes is helping to train 110 young trainees in composting techniques (biofertiliser production) and the maintenance of production tools over a 24-month period.

### SOME OTHER AEJ INITIATIVES

### **FINANCING PILOT PROJECTS**

e.g.: MODERN PLASTIC WASTE MANUFACTURER (Manufacture of tables and benches for schools, boards, paving stones and miscellaneous items made from recycled plastic) PRODUCTION OF HIGH-YIELD NATURAL MANURE

### **GREEN JOB TRAINING**

e.g. 197 young people trained in biomass production (production of compost, biochar, biogas), production of juice from cashew apples, etc.

### **IMPLEMENTATION OF THIMO**

15,000 young people to work in 2022 and 2023 to clean up localities
