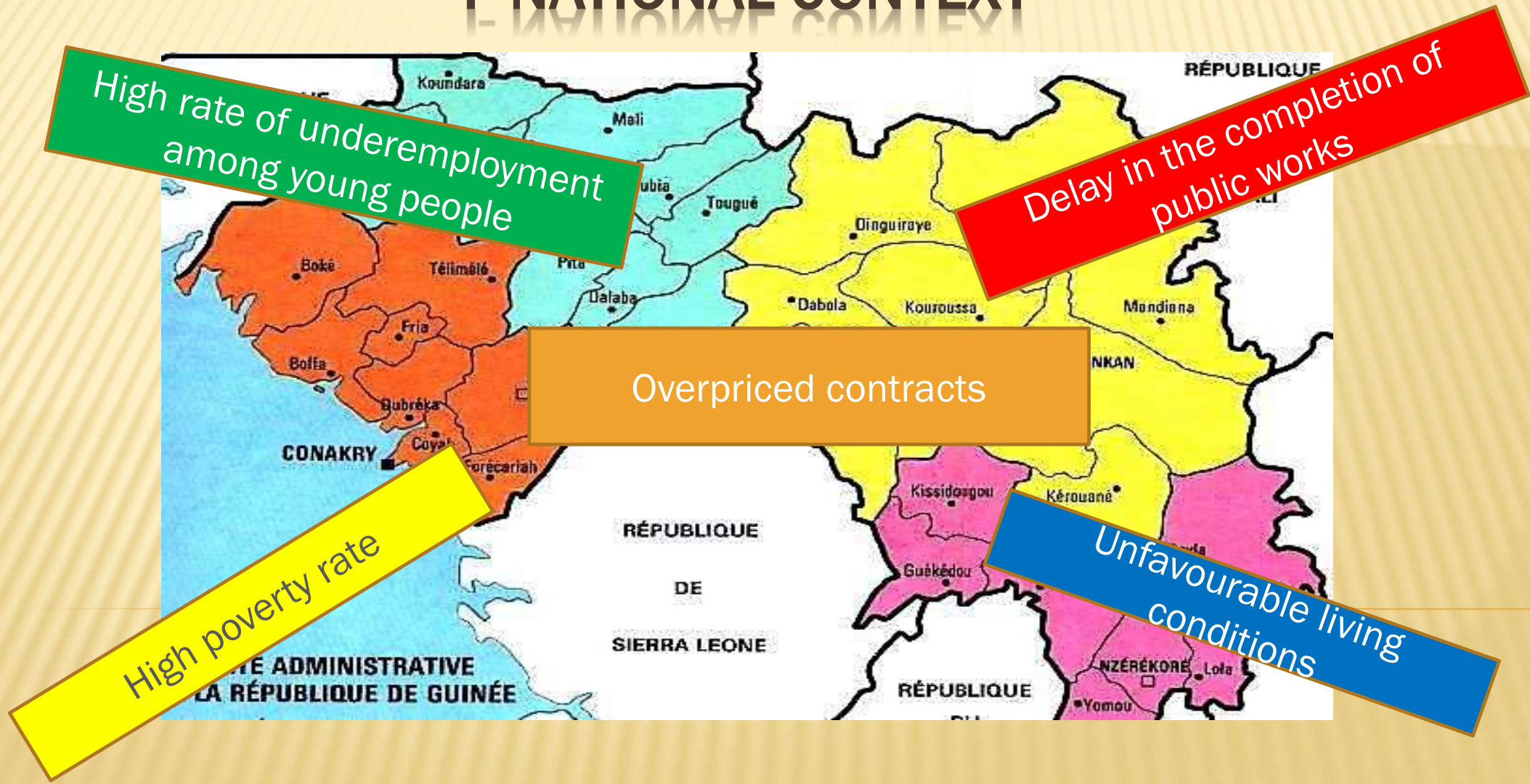

I- NATIONAL CONTEXT



II. CREATION

1993: Creation of the enforcement agency by civil society, which was called Agence d'Exécution de Conakry (AGECO);

1996: The World Bank and the Guinean government set up the first AGETIPE. Unfortunately, problems prevented it from functioning.

2000: A third attempt, at the sole initiative of the Guinean government, led to the establishment of AGETIPE-Guinea under the supervision of the Prime Minister's Office.

2001: Membership of the AFRICATIP network

2002 Effective start-up of AGETIPE-GUINEE activities

2013, the Guinean government decided to transform AGETIPE-Guinea into a public administrative institution under the supervision of the Ministry of Youth and Youth Employment by Decree D/2013/135/PRG/SGG of 12 August 2013,

IV. MISSIONS

AGETIPE's mission must be carried out in accordance with simplified and transparent procedures designed to promote:

➤ 1. Public interest missions

To deliver development projects on time and on budget.

To support public administration departments, local authorities and any other public or private entity in carrying out public programmes and projects.

Maintaining and developing partnerships with local authorities, national and international institutions and organisations in carrying out programmes and projects of public interest;

IV. MISSIONS

➤ 2. Job creation

Encourage the use of the High Intensity Labour Force (HIMO) approach, wherever technically possible and economically viable,

Stimulate the recruitment of unskilled staff by building and public works companies and other services working on the various sites;

Create at least temporary jobs

IV. MISSIONS

➤ 3. Capacity building in the construction and public works sector

To encourage and promote the development of the national private sector, in particular design offices and small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) in the building and public works (BTP) sector in general;

To help build the capacity of local private companies, associations, consultancies and consultancy firms in terms of studies, implementation and supervision in the implementation of development programmes and projects;

Encouraging the involvement of local private companies, associations, consultancies and advisory firms in sustainable economic and social development initiatives.

V. ORGANISATION

AGETIPE has legal personality and financial and management autonomy in accordance with the legislation and regulations in force governing Public Establishments of an Administrative Nature, in particular law L / 056, and comprises the following bodies

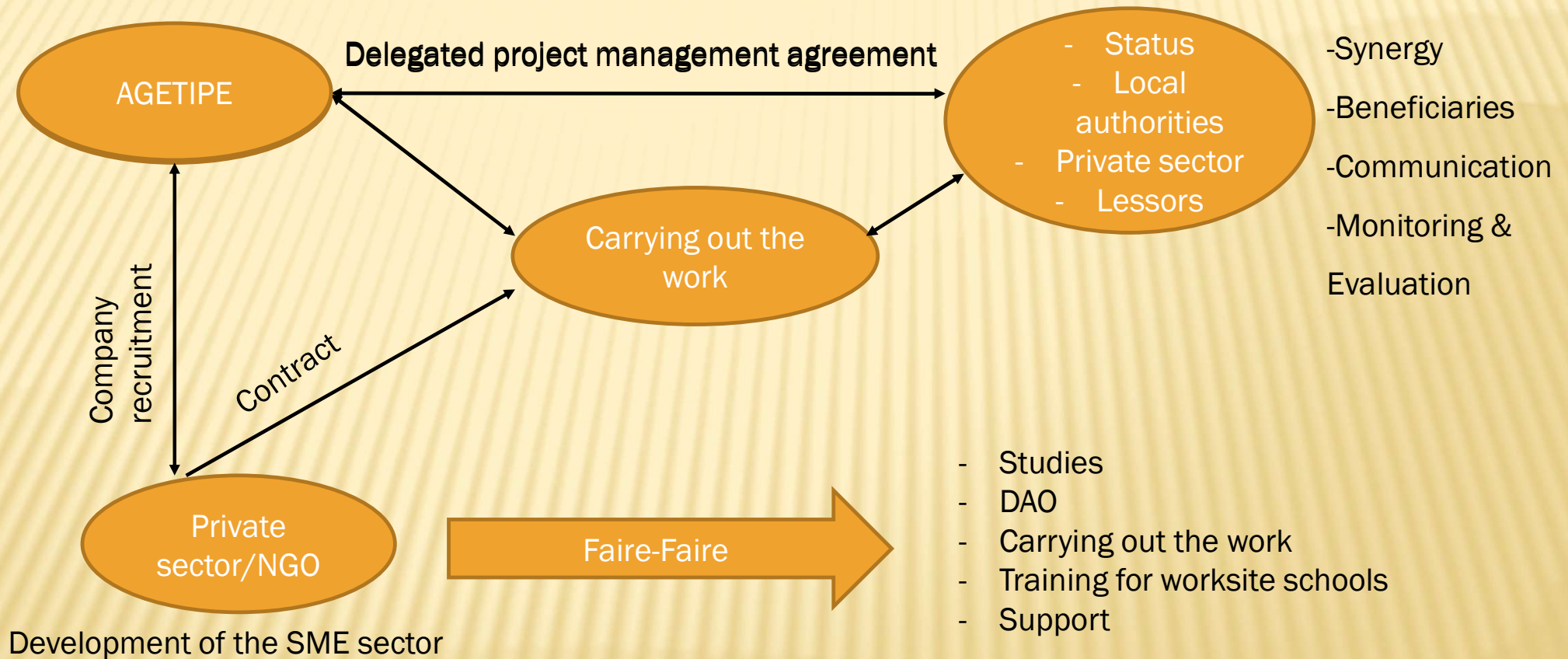

In accordance with the provisions of the public procurement code, in particular article 14 AGETIPE acts as a delegated project manager (MOD) on behalf of principals who may be :

- central and devolved administration,
- local and regional authorities,
- development projects and programmes,
- private stakeholders; financial backers

VIII. ACTIVITIES CARRIED OUT

- ✘ Rehabilitation of the northern and southern cornices of Kaloum ;
- ✘ The construction of 12 schools in the Kankan region with the Education For All Programme (PEPT);
- ✘ Construction of the Sonfonia primary market, sector 4, with UNDP support;
- ✘ The recruitment, training and supervision of 1,000 young workers, including 500 recruited for the Kaléta hydroelectric dam project;
- ✘ The programme to strengthen 600 companies in the preparation of tender documents (DAO) and HIMO techniques;
- ✘ Completion of the first pilot phase of the project to pave roads and pavements in the city of Conakry (Kaloum and Matoto);
- ✘ The creation and support of 100 agricultural youth groups (men and women) in 26 prefectures;
- ✘ The recruitment of 250 young people to raise awareness, monitor and follow up the project "Youth involvement in the cleanliness of the city of Conakry" initiated by the Ministry of Territorial Administration and Decentralisation;

VIII. ACTIVITIES CARRIED OUT

continued

- ✘ The recruitment of 3,300 young people in the campaign to clean up the city of Conakry through awareness-raising activities, gutter cleaning, elimination of black spots, control and monitoring in partnership with the Ministry of Public Works;
- ✘ The creation and support of four (04) Economic Interest Groups (EIGs) and Cooperatives of young artisanal fishermen in Conakry;
- ✘ The recruitment and training of 250 young people in the prefabrication of cobblestones and 150 other young people in earthworks and cobblestone laying, with financial support from the UNDP, in the commune of Ratoma;
- ✘ Carrying out technical studies as part of the second pilot phase of the project to pave roads, pavements and public squares in the urban communes of Boké, Gueckedou, Kouroussa and Matoto and the rural communes of Maleah and Tintinia in the prefecture of Siguiiri;
- ✘ Implementation of the "INTEGRA" socio-economic integration programme for young people in partnership with Enabel (Belgian Development Agency).
