HISTORICAL DEVELOPMENT

- Territorial Labour Office since 1954;
- Office National de la Main d'Œuvre (ONMO) with independence (1960);
- From 1984 onwards, as a result of the SAPs, the ONMO was restructured into the ONMOE to take account of employment in all its dimensions;
- In 2001, ONMOE was restructured and transformed into an ANPE, with financial autonomy and legal personality, whose main mission is to contribute to the implementation of the National Employment Policy adopted in 1998;
- In 2012, the ANPE adopted a Strategic Development Plan, which is now in its 3^{ème} phase for the period 2021-2025;
- In 2014, Ordinance No. 18-016/P-RM of 27/02/2001 and Law No. 01-019 of 30/05/2001 were revised to reflect the creation of ONEF and refocus its missions. This led to the replacement of the DOEF by the DPS and the creation of the CEP.

THE MISSIONS OF ANPE

- The ANPE's mission is to contribute to the implementation of Mali's National Employment Policy. To this end, it is responsible for:
 - Canvassing, collecting job offers from employers and matching job supply and demand;
 - o To welcome, inform and guide jobseekers;
 - Promoting self-employment through information and guidance for future entrepreneurs;
 - Carry out any activities related to its missions that may be entrusted to it by the State, local authorities or public establishments;
 - o Carry out studies on employment and vocational training;
 - Helping to implement vocational training, further training, retraining and integration activities;
 - Designing and implementing mechanisms and actions to promote employment, particularly for women and people with disabilities.

MAIN AREAS OF INTERVENTION

- Intermediation;
- Promoting self-employment;
- Further training and retraining;
- Cooperation and professional migration;
- · Studies and research on employment; and
- Communication.



ANPE'S PSD 2021 - 2025

- The ANPE, in the search for better execution of its mission to contribute to the implementation of the National Employment Policy, has adopted a Strategic Development Plan (SDP) 2021 2025 which succeeds the first SDP executed in 2 phases: 2012-2016 and 2016 2020.
- The strategy of this PSD is built around a development objective which is: "To make the ANPE, by 2025, a high-performance Public Employment Service promoting employment and skills for all", broken down into five Immediate Strategic Objectives.

ANPE'S EXPERIENCE OF GREEN JOBS

- The promotion of self-employment and studies and research on employment have made it possible to develop and implement programmes to promote green jobs through:
 - The Jatropha chain;
 - Structuring or integrating projects;
 - Waste processing and recovery;
 - Partnership to promote green jobs,



the jatropha plant:

- Jatropha cultivation as part of "Action Research" in the Kayes, Koulikoro, Sikasso and Ségou regions;
- The installation of Jatropha nurseries in the same localities;
- Jatropha processing into fuel, oil and soap (Keleya, Koulikoro, Bancoumana, Kita and San);

There are currently four main Jatropha oil production units in the regions of Kayes, Koulikoro, Sikasso and Ségou.






STRUCTURING / INTEGRATED PROJECT

- A structuring or integrated project is made up of interdependent sub-projects that create jobs in the same area. These are social and collective investments in complementary areas, for example :
 - Fattening Market gardening ;
 - Fish farming Poultry farming Market gardening.
- The ANPE has carried out 4 structuring or integrated pilot projects in the regions of Kayes (1), Koulikoro (1) and Ségou (2).



STRUCTURING/INTEGRATED PROJECT PLAN



WASTE PROCESSING AND RECOVERY

- Support and installation of project holders in the transformation of plastic waste into:
 - Production of paving stones and traffic humps;
 - Pellet production;
 - Fan, rope and basket making;
 - Manufacture furniture, handbags, hats and other decorative items.
- The ANPE, the Société d'Etudes et de Recherches Industrielles du Mali (SERIM), the Fonds Auto Renouvelable pour l'Emploi (FARE) and partner banks have implemented the 37 Enterprise "3P" project (Promoteurs des Petites et Moyennes Entreprises Personnelles), which has created two hundred and fifty (250) jobs in environmental management.

CONCLUSION

- The ANPE's experience in the field of green jobs is rich and varied, for example: the Jatropha programme for the production of biofuel and initiatives to transform and recycle non-biodegradable waste.
- The ANPE Mali remains attentive to the needs of its user-clients and partners, with a view to capitalising on the experience gained and developing the various sectors in order to promote related entrepreneurship.
