### I. Accommodation

# IV. Getting to the Hotel From the Airport

The organisers are pleased to provide free transport to and from the event venue for all participants. # V. Sightseeing

Participants who wish to take advantage of their trip to Malaysia to explore Kuala Lumpur are recommended to purchase tickets for the KL Hop On Hop Off tour bus, which travels in a loop around the city centre and stops at major tourist attractions such as the Malaysian Parliament, the National Monument, and various historical houses of worship. The bus route stops right in front of the event venue so participants can easily board after the conference, provided they have already purchased tickets online.

Tickets are priced at RM60 per adult (please refer to section X on currency exchange) and allow the ticket holder to freely board any KL Hop On Hop Off tour bus within a 24-hour timeframe. Please visit the official website for more information and to purchase tickets online.

The average daytime temperature in Kuala Lumpur in July is 32 °C (89 °F). Afternoons can be extremely hot and humid. Nighttime temperatures generally hover around 24 °C (75 °F), although it normally feels hotter due to the high humidity.

Malaysia is 8 hours ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (UTC / GMT+8).


# VIII. International Dialling Codes

The country code for Malaysia is 60. The area code for Kuala Lumpur is 3.

To make an international phone call, dial 00 + country code + area code (if dialling a landline) + phone number.

# IX. Electricity Supply

Electricity is supplied at a voltage of 240V and 50Hz. Malaysia uses the Type G socket also common in Singapore and the United Kingdom.



# X. Currency, Banking, Credit Cards and ATMs

The official currency in Malaysia is the Malaysian Ringgit (RM), where each RM is worth 100 sen. Currency is available in the following denominations:

- Banknotes: RM1, RM5, RM10, RM20, RM50, RM100
- Coins: 5 sen, 10 sen, 20 sen, 50 sen.

Daily exchange rates can be found on the Central Bank of Malaysia website.

While cash can easily be exchanged at the airport or at major shopping malls where many money changers operate, participants are encouraged to withdraw RM directly from an ATM for the best exchange rate. Please ensure you activate your credit or debit card for overseas use before travel. Alternatively, cash-free payment facilities are common in Kuala Lumpur, so participants may consider paying directly with a credit or debit card.

Banking hours are generally from 09:00 to 17:00, Monday to Friday. Some may close for lunch.
