# **II.** Entry into Ivory Coast

## A) Visa requirements

Please note that all participants are responsible for obtaining a visa to enter the country. Please also contact your Ministry of Foreign Affairs if necessary. For further information, you can also consult the <u>E-visa – SNEDAI GROUPE</u> website and obtain information on evisa procedures (e-visa, exempted countries, etc.).

If you need a letter of invitation to obtain a visa, please indicate this when you register online, giving us details of your flight details and exact dates of arrival and departure.

## B) Yellow fever

To enter Ivory Coast, you must be vaccinated against yellow fever in order to prevent the international spread of the disease and to protect individual travellers who may be exposed to yellow fever infection.

# III. How to get from the airport to the hotels

Shuttles will be provided between the airport and the hotels listed above. You will need to provide us with your flight plans as soon as possible so that we can organise your pick-up.

# IV. From the meeting venue to the hotels

Shuttle buses will be available to take you between the hotels listed above and the various venues.

If you choose another hotel, you will have to arrange your own transfers.

The public transport options in Abidjan are as follows:

• Official taxis (metered taxis)







Metered taxis can be found in Abidjan and are generally identifiable by their orange or red colour.

#### Recommendations:

- Favour metered taxis to avoid complicated negotiations.
- Use local apps such as Yango or Heetch to order journeys in complete safety.
- Check that the driver is familiar with your destination.

## • Private chauffeur-driven transport

This option is ideal for visitors who want a personalised, secure service. Companies such as AVIS, Europear or local agencies offer this service.

#### Advantages:

- Comfort and reliability.
- Local knowledge of the driver.
- Often offered with an air-conditioned vehicle, which is appreciated in tropical climates

# • VTC (chauffeur-driven car) applications

## Popular recommendations:

- Yango: Widely used in Abidjan, offers clear pricing and a reliable service.
- Uber or Heetch: Two other popular local apps.

Advantages: Transparent pricing, real-time tracking and security.

In general, the average temperature in Abidjan at the beginning of May is 30°C (86°F). As the month progresses, temperatures tend to fall moderately, reaching an average of 29°C (84.2°F) at the end of May.

# VI. Time zone

Abidjan is located in the UTC +0 time zone (Coordinated Universal Time).

# VII. International dialling code

The international dialling code for Ivory Coast is +225.







For Abidjan, which is the largest city in Ivory Coast, you also use the +225 area code, followed by the specific local number. There is no separate area code for Abidjan; it uses the same area code as the rest of the country.

# VIII. Electricity supply

The main voltage for electricity in **Abidjan** (and throughout Côte d'Ivoire) is **220 volts** at a frequency of **50 Hz**.



Type C and E electrical sockets are used.

#### IX. Dress code

#### • For official (formal) sessions:

- Men: Light suit (breathable fabric, such as cotton or linen) with tie, or dress shirt. A jacket may be optional depending on the heat.
- Women: Dresses or business suits (trousers or skirt with blouse). Choose light fabrics and sober colours.
- Local option: Guests can also wear elegant traditional African outfits, such as a boubou, pagne or kaba.

#### • For cultural or informal events:

- Men: Short-sleeved shirt or traditional African shirt (e.g. bazin shirt or local printed fabric).
- Women: Dress or relaxed but elegant outfit. Garments made from loincloth or local prints are particularly popular.

#### • Climate and culture:

- Climate: Côte d'Ivoire has a tropical climate. Choose light, breathable and comfortable clothing, while maintaining a professional style for official sessions.
- Cultural respect: Avoid clothes that are too short, transparent or provocative, out of respect for local norms.

#### • Accessories and other recommendations:

- Participants can incorporate local clothing to show their interest in Ivorian culture.
- Bring hats or caps for outdoor activities.
- Wear comfortable shoes, suitable for long working days or visits.
- Bring appropriate clothing for gala evenings (cocktail dress or more formal suit).







# X. Money, banks, credit cards and ATMs

The official currency in Abidjan (and Côte d'Ivoire) is the CFA Franc (XOF), available in the following denominations:

Coins: CFA 1, 5, 10, 25, 50, 100 and 200

Banknotes: 500, 1,000, 2,000, 5,000 and 10,000 CFA francs.

Exchange rates are published in Ivorian newspapers and can also be consulted on the website of the Central Bank of West African States (BCEAO) at the following address: www.bceao.int

Banking hours are generally 08:00 to 12:00 and 14:00 to 16:00, Monday to Friday (some branches close for lunch).

ATMs are available throughout Abidjan, accepting all major credit and debit cards, and instructions are often available in English.

# XIII. Cultural visit of May 9th

# Tour of the historic city of Grand Bassam

The first capital of Côte d'Ivoire, the Historic Town of Grand-Bassam, is an example of a late 19th- and early 20th-century colonial town planned with quarters specializing in commerce, administration, housing for Europeans and for Africans. The site includes the N'zima African fishing village alongside colonial architecture marked by functional houses with galleries, verandas and gardens. Grand-Bassam was the most important port, economic and judicial centre of Côte d'Ivoire. It bears witness to the complex social relations between Europeans and Africans, and to the subsequent independence movement. As a vibrant centre of the territory of French trading posts in the Gulf of Guinea, which preceded modern Côte d'Ivoire, it attracted populations from all parts of Africa, Europe and the Mediterranean Levant. - 8:00 a.m.: Departure from Abidjan bus journey (45 min. to 1 hour depending on traffic)
- 9:00 a.m.: Arrival and visit to the Quartier France (UNESCO World Heritage Site)
  - Exploration of the iconic colonial buildings: Former Governor's Palace Former Post Office Ganamet House Sacred Heart Church
  - Explanation of the colonial history and the role of Grand-Bassam as the first capital of the Ivory Coast.
- 10:00 a.m.: Visit to the National Costume Museum Collection of traditional Ivorian clothing and cultural objects. History and significance of ethnic dress.
- 10:45 a.m.: Stroll through the craft market Discover local crafts (sculptures, loincloths, jewellery, decorative objects). Opportunity to buy souvenirs and chat with the artisans.
- 11.30 am: Relaxation break by the lagoon or on the beach
  - Refreshments in a maguis or restaurant by the sea.
  - Tasting of a local juice (bissap, ginger) or a local speciality such as alloco or braised fish.
- 12.30 pm: Return to Abidjan
